WHEREAS, the film, set and shot in the former Schenley High School building in Pittsburgh's North Oakland neighborhood by **Indian Paintbrush**, who later partnered with **Fox Searchlight Pictures** for worldwide distribution, is a testament to the flourishing film industry that has contributed so significantly to the dynamic growth of our City on the international stage; and,
