Resolution authorizing the Mayor and the Director of City Planning of the City of Pittsburgh to enter into grant agreements with the Pennsylvania Museum and Historical Commission for a grant in the amount of \$25,000. Additionally the 2014 Cultural Heritage Plan Community Development Block Grant will be utilized to provide a match to the PHMC grant in the amount of \$25,000 to complete a National Register nomination of the Lawrenceville neighborhood.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of City Planning of the City of Pittsburgh are authorized to execute relevant agreements with the Pennsylvania Museum and Historical Commission in order to receive a grant award of twenty-five-thousand dollars (\$25,000) to complete a National Register nomination for the Lawrenceville neighborhood. The Grant Agreement shall be approved as to form and substance by the City Solicitor and monies shall be deposited into the account 1129400157.45505.00.

Section 2. The Mayor and the Director of City Planning of the City of Pittsburgh are further authorized to enter into an Agreements, or Contract, or utilize existing Agreements or Contracts, in a form approved by the City Solicitor and not to exceed twenty-five-thousand (\$25,000) dollars, to complete a National Register nomination for the Lawrenceville neighborhood under the terms of the agreement between the City and the Pennsylvania Museum and Historical Commission. Said agreement or agreements, contract or contracts, or expenditures shall not exceed twenty-five-thousand (\$25,000) dollars chargeable to and payable from the Grants Trust Fund
