Resolution authorizing the Mayor and the Director of the Office of Management & Budget to enter into a Contract or Agreement with MAYA Design for graphic design, branding, and application support for the City's Smart City Challenge grant for a sum not to exceed Twenty Five Thousand and Five Hundred Dollars (\$25,500.00) and for the payment of the costs thereof.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Office of Management & Budget, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into a Contract or Agreement with MAYA Design for graphic design, branding, and application support for the City's Smart City Challenge grant application to the US Department of Transportation for a sum not to exceed Twenty Five Thousand and Five Hundred Dollars (\$25,500.00) from Smart City Concept Development and Planning grant fund in the Grants Trust Fund.

Funds shall be paid from the following accounts:

Said Contract or Agreement shall be in a form approved by the City Solicitor.
