**WHEREAS**, the parish of the Holy Assumption of St Mary Orthodox Church was established in 1916 as the SS. Peter and Paul Russian Orthodox Church; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Church was renamed in honor of the Theotokos after being forced to move in the early 1930's and regaining the building in January of 1943; and,

**WHEREAS**, Archimandrite Seraphim was appointed as the first pastor of the Holy Assumption of St Mary Orthodox Church in 1943 and Father John Waschak became its second pastor in 1955; and,

**WHEREAS**, the church has served food to over 30000 community members in need since founding the St. Cyril of White Lake Food Pantry in 2010; and,

**WHEREAS**, the rich history of the Holy Assumption of St Mary Orthodox Church is lined with a constant support of the surrounding community and imbued with a spirit of charity and service;
