**WHEREAS**, for over 70 years, the ECP has been providing opportunities for active individuals to stay active by learning new skills and meeting new friends who share a passion for the physical and mental challenges of the outdoors; and,

**WHEREAS**, in addition to outdoor sports, the group offers three schools throughout the year for members to learn backpacking, rock climbing and/or mountaineering and they enjoy sponsoring environmental and community service projects; and,

**WHEREAS**, one such community service project is their annual Mount Washington Cleanup which will be held on Saturday, April 8 of this year; and,

**WHEREAS**, what makes this cleanup so unique, however, is that there are several sections of hillside along Grandview Avenue that require climbing skills with the use of a rope and harness which is where Club members volunteer their time and skills; and,

**WHEREAS**, this year's cleanup will mark the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the members of ECP giving of their time to
