Resolution authorizing the Mayor and Director of the Office of Management and Budget to enter into an agreement with the PA Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) Community Conservation Partnerships Program (C2P2), should the grant be awarded by DCNR, to provide funding for the Wightman Park Development Project providing upgrades to the park including green infrastructure. Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Office of Management and Budget of the City of Pittsburgh are authorized to enter into an agreement with the PA Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) Community Conservation Partnerships Program (C2P2), should the grant be awarded by DCNR, in order to receive a grant award for FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$500,000.00) dollars to support the Wightman Park Development Project providing upgrades to the park including green infrastructure. In the event the grant is awarded, monies from the grant agreement shall be deposited into the Grants Trust Fund.
