Ordinance amending and supplementing the Pittsburgh Code, Title One - Administrative, Article XI - Personnel, Chapter 191 - Retirement, Section 191.06 - Compulsory Retirement.

## The Council of the City of Pittsburgh hereby enacts as follows:

**Section 1.** The Pittsburgh Code, Title One - Administrative, Article XI - Personnel, Chapter 191 - Retirement, Section 191.06 - Compulsory Retirement, is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

### § 191.06 - COMPULSORY RETIREMENT.

- (a.) Each fire<u>fighter</u> [man and policeman] who attains the age of sixty-five (65) years shall retire from service. The term[s "fireman" and "policeman" mean] "firefighter" [s and police officers and] shall not include the Fire Chief or the Superintendent of Police.
- (b.) <u>Each police officer who attains the age of seventy (70) years shall retire from service. The term "police officer"</u> shall not include the Chief of Police.
