Resolution authorizing the Mayor and the Director of City Planning of the City of Pittsburgh to accept a grant from the Pennsylvania Museum and Historical Commission in the amount of eighteen thousand (\$18,000) dollars. This grant will be used in conjunction with department funds to execute contracts for an architectural inventory of historic structures in the city not to exceed thirty-six thousand (\$36,000) dollars.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of City Planning of the City of Pittsburgh are authorized to execute relevant agreements with the Pennsylvania Museum and Historical Commission in order to receive a grant award of eighteen-thousand (\$18,000) for the architectural inventory of historic structures in the City. The Grant Agreement shall be approved as to form and substance by the City Solicitor and monies shall be deposited into the account 1129400240.45505.00.

Section 2. The Mayor and the Director of City Planning of the City of Pittsburgh are further authorized to enter into an Agreement, or Contract, or utilize existing Agreements or Contracts, in a form approved by the City Solicitor and not to exceed eighteen-thousand dollars (\$18,000), for the architectural inventory of historic structures in the City under the terms of the agreement between the City and the Pennsylvania Museum and Historical Commission. Said agreement or agreements, contract or contracts, or expenditures shall not exceed eighteen-thousand dollars (\$18,000) chargeable to and payable from the Grants Trust Fund account 1129400240.50000.00.

In addition, The Mayor and the Director of City Planning of the City of Pittsburgh are further authorized to enter into an Agreement, or Contract, or utilize existing Agreements or Contracts, in a form approved by the City Solicitor and not to exceed eighteen-thousand (\$18,000) dollars cash match, for the architectural inventory of historic structures in the City under the terms of the agreement between the City and the Pennsylvania Museum and Historical Commission. Said agreement or agreements, contract or contracts, or expenditures shall not exceed five-thousand (\$5,000) dollars chargeable to and payable from 2014 CDBG funds account 1167383140.58101.00 and thirteen-thousand (\$13,000) dollars chargeable to and payable from 2015 Capital funds account 1126738315.53901.00. The total amount of the contract shall not exceed thirty-six thousand (\$36,000) dollars.
