### Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

**Section 1.** The City of Pittsburgh is hereby authorized to donate certain real estate properties as required for implementation of Bedford Dwellings/Hill District CNIG Application's Housing Plan and any subsequent revisions as approved by U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

**Section 2.** The appraised value of donated properties will be committed as a financial leverage to facilitate the implementation of the Bedford Dwellings/Hill District CNIG Application's Housing Plan and contribute to HUD's competitive scoring factor of financial leverage for the CNIG Application.
