Resolution declaring that certain City property, as further provided herein, in Highland Park shall be dedicated to a trail easement and that certain other property be dedicated to a temporary construction easement in order to facilitate development of the Washington Boulevard Trail.

**WHEREAS,** The City has proposed a mixed use bicycle and pedestrian path to provide safe passage for non-motorized travel through certain City-owned property along Washington Boulevard in the neighborhood of Highland Park (“the Project”); and

**WHEREAS,** Formation of this bicycle and pedestrian path requires 1) the dedication of a small portion of said property as a trail easement to the public and 2) the dedication of a small portion of said property as a temporary construction easement to facilitate Project construction; and

**WHEREAS,** after Project completion, the public will retain the ability to use the dedicated area for non-motorized transport and other recreational travel; and

**WHEREAS,** therefore the City has agreed to dedicate a portion of City-owned property in the neighborhood of Highland Park to: 1) a temporary construction easement to facilitate construction of the Project and 2) a trail easement to provide that the area be used as a trail for the benefit of the public.

**Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:**

**Section 1.** It is hereby declared that City property further described in Exhibits A (legal description) and B (“Washington Boulevard Trail Plan,”), which are attached hereto and incorporated herein, shall hereafter officially be dedicated to the ascribed purposes defined therein, namely to a trail easement and temporary construction easement.

**Section 2.** The Department of Mobility and Infrastructure is authorized to record this completed legislation with the Allegheny County Recorder of Deeds as memorialization of this dedication.
