WHEREAS, **Jada House** is a social ministry of healing established by Terri Shields in 2014 to assist and reflect on social and personal daily issues like spiritual awareness, self-esteem, creativity awareness and family values; and,

WHEREAS, as a non-profit, faith based community outreach, **Jada House** provides teens 13-17, juniors 6-12 and adults with a safe place to educate each other in believing success is a possibility and that each person has a rightful place in our community; and,

WHEREAS, Jada House originally met in Terri Shields' home but since its inception has grown large enough to have its own space in the Spartan Center in Hazelwood and sponsors community activities like a Toy Drive, Senior Luncheon and a Backpack collection. A graduate of Carlow College with a Bachelor's Degree in Communications, Terri overcame personal and health struggles to become a Social Worker with a vison and a mission that established Jada House; and,
