Resolution requesting authorization for the Mayor and the Manager of the Office of Municipal Investigations (“OMI”) to enter into an Agreement or Agreements with Assured Polygraph Services, for an amount not to exceed Twenty-Four Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$24,000) to conduct public safety candidate pre-employment polygraph examinations and/or testimony in Civil Service decertification hearings regarding.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and Manager of the Office of Municipal Investigations, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement/Agreements with Assured Polygraph Services to conduct public safety candidate pre-employment background investigations and/or testify in Civil Service decertification hearings.

Section 2. The Agreement shall be chargeable to and payable form the following account for an amount not to exceed \$24,000.00:
