WHEREAS, Friday, September 4 - Monday, September 7, 2020, the Allegheny/Fayette Central Labor Council will celebrate Labor Day by holding Labor's Weekend of Service in honor of frontline workers and organized labor's commitment to serve our communities and take care of those in need; and,

WHEREAS, the Labor Day Parade has been the largest event to honor union workers, but due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the parade has been cancelled. Fortunately, under Darrin Kelly's leadership, and the help of local union members, the alternative "Labor's Weekend of Service" will continue the tradition of honoring past, present and future members; and,

WHEREAS, during this weekend, the Allegheny/Fayette Central Labor Council held a food distribution hosted, in conjunction with the Greater Pittsburgh Community Food Bank and the Pittsburgh Penguins, where more than 200 union volunteers showed up and served more than 500 cars; and,
