Resolution authorizing the Mayor and the Chief Equity Officer to enter into an agreement or agreements with Nth Party in order to collect and provide disaggregated data related to a pay equity initiative designed to reduce the gender pay gap in Pittsburgh and further providing for the expenditures under the terms of said agreements at a cost not to exceed TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000).

**Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:**

**Section 1.** The Mayor and the Chief Equity Officer are hereby authorized to execute relevant agreements with the Nth Party in order to collect and provide disaggregated data related to a pay equity initiative designed to reduce the gender pay gap in Pittsburgh.

**Section 2.** The Mayor and the Chief Equity Officer are further authorized to make all legitimate expenditures required under the terms of conditions of the agreement(s) outlined in Section 1 of this resolution. Said agreement or agreements, contract or contracts, or expenditures shall not exceed TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000) chargeable to and payable from the following account: 11101.102100.53.53901.2020.

**Section 3.** Said agreement or agreements shall be in a form approved by the City Solicitor.
