Resolution amending Resolution 55 of 2018, which authorized the Mayor to execute relevant agreements to receive grant funding to plan and implement the creation of Financial Empowerment Centers Fund within the City of Pittsburgh, to enter into a Professional Service Agreement or Agreements with Neighborhood Allies for the continued operation of Financial Empower Centers for the City and further authorizing agreements or contracts and expenditures not to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000).

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Chief Equity Officer of the City of Pittsburgh are hereby authorized to execute relevant Professional Services Agreements or Contracts or utilize existing Agreements or Contracts with Neighborhood Allies and Cities for Financial Empowerment (CFE) Fund for the continued operation of Financial Empowerment Centers for the City of Pittsburgh at a cost not to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000).

Section 2. Monies from the agreement shall be chargeable and payable from the Grants Trust Fund account 0229400226.53901.00.
