Resolution authorizing the Mayor and the Director of the Department of Mobility and Infrastructure to enter into a contribution and cooperation agreement with the Pittsburgh Water and Sewer Authority (PWSA) for certain utility relocation and other work elements in connection with the South Side Signals Project.

WHEREAS, the City is advancing the South Side Signals project (“Project”), which will replace the traffic signal infrastructure at 6 intersections along S 18<sup>th</sup> Street and Brownsville Road and includes sidewalk extensions, improved signing and pavement markings, and upgraded street lights; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Project, certain facilities of the PWSA must be relocated, constructed, or otherwise adjusted; and

WHEREAS, the City now wishes to enter into an agreement with PWSA to provide for the utility relocation, construction, other adjustments made necessary as a result of the Project.

**Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:**

**Section 1.** The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Mobility and Infrastructure are authorized to enter into a contribution and cooperation agreement with PWSA for certain utility relocation and other work

elements in connection with the South Side Signals Project.
