Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and Director of the Department of Public Works, are hereby authorized to apply for grant funding from the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources' Community Conservation Partnership Program, to provide funding for the Allegheny Riverfront Park Renovation Project.
