WHEREAS, the City of Pittsburgh requires as part of its Independence Day Festival, professional services for waste management services; and

WHEREAS, Pennsylvania Resources Council, was selected through a competitive process as qualified for the performance of said professional services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pittsburgh now wishes to enter into an agreement with Pennsylvania Resources Council for the performance of a waste management services in conjunction with the City of Pittsburgh's Independence Day Festival.

## Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

**Section 1.** The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Public Safety, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, are authorized to enter into a professional services agreement with Pennsylvania Resources Council
