Whereas, the Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh has requested authorization to execute a Contract for Disposition by Sale of Land by and between the Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh and Katie Holler, in connection with the sale of Block 50-F, Lot 148, in the 10th Ward of the City of Pittsburgh, for the sum of \$11,200 plus costs;

Section 1.
