Ordinance accepting a new street name, HERTZOG WAY in the Twenty-Seventh Ward of the City of Pittsburgh as per recommendation by the City of Pittsburgh Addressing Committee (CPAC). The following street name was approved by CPAC in September 2022. The name listed in this ordinance shall be made official in accordance with the Pittsburgh Code, Title Four, Public Places and Property, Chapter 420 Uniform Street Naming and Addressing.

The Council of the City of Pittsburgh hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. That the name of HERTZOG WAY, along its entire length beginning at its terminus at its easterly end to its intersection with Fleming Ave at its westerly end, shall be and the same is hereby approved, located in the Twenty-Seventh Ward.
