The following street name was approved by CPAC in September 2022. The name listed in this ordinance shall be made official in accordance with the Pittsburgh Code, Title Four, Public Places and Property, Chapter 420 Uniform Street Naming and Addressing.

## The Council of the City of Pittsburgh hereby enacts as follows:

**Section 1.** That the name of BANKSVILLE PARK DR, along its entire length beginning at its intersection with Crane Ave at its westerly end to its terminus at its northeasterly end, shall be and the same is hereby approved, located in the Twentieth Ward.
