*WHEREAS*, Ms. Jackson’s swift and effective performance of CPR saved this woman’s life; and,

*WHEREAS*, the Executive Director, the Board, and the staff of the Pittsburgh Parking Authority recognize and celebrate outstanding commitment to and performance of duty and commitment by the employees of the Authority.
