WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Senior Games feature a spirit of competition and kinship among Pennsylvania seniors in a safe, productive, mentally and physically stimulating atmosphere; and

WHEREAS, the 25th Annual Pennsylvania Senior Games, held July 13th through July 17th at Shippensburg University welcomed 46 senior delegates from various area centers representing the Citiparks SeniorInterests Program; and
