WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Senior Games feature a spirit of competition and kinship among Pennsylvania seniors in a safe, productive, mentally and physically stimulating atmosphere; and

WHEREAS, the 25th Annual Pennsylvania Senior Games, held July 13<sup>th</sup> through July 17<sup>th</sup> at Shippensburg University welcomed 46 senior delegates from various area centers representing the Citiparks Senior *Interests* Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pittsburgh Senior *Interests* contingent brought home a total of 212 medals, including 85 gold, 66 silver and 61 bronze; and
