Resolution declaring that City property known as Junction Hollow shall be dedicated for public park purposes and shall further become part of Schenley Park.

**WHEREAS**, the City owns 27.886 ± acres know as “Junction Hollow” (the “parcels”) located in the 4<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> Wards of the City of Pittsburgh; and

**WHEREAS**, the parcels are further described in EXHIBIT A, which is attached hereto; and

**WHEREAS**, the City now desires to officially dedicate the parcels for public park purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, the parcel is located adjacent to Schenley Park, and the City wishes to expand the boundaries of Schenley Park to now include said parcel.

**Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:**

**Section 1.** It is hereby declared that the above-described parcel shall hereafter officially be dedicated for park purposes and shall be added to the boundary of Schenley Park.
