Be it resolved that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The Pittsburgh Code, Title One, Administrative, Article VII Procedures, Chapter 161 Contracts, is hereby supplemented by adding a new section 161.36 entitled "Contract Disclosure."

§161.36 Contract Disclosure

<u>All vendor RFP responses should include a disclosure of any finder's fees, fee splitting, firm affiliation or relationship with any broker-dealer, payments to consultants, lobbyists, or commissioned representatives or other contractual arrangements of the firm that could present a real or perceived conflict of interest.</u>
