Dr. Jones is nationally known as a key figure in choral conducting and an expert in the area of infusing theology and musical expression. Throughout his careen, Dr. Jones has served as a choral conductor, educator, operatic bassbaritone, liturgical dancer, and pastor. He has performed at venues across the United States and Europe; and
