WHEREAS, **Leading by Example Men's Mentorship Program**, is a component of the ministry that assists men in the healthy spiritual, emotional and physical maintenance, as well as addressing relevant men's issues;

WHEREAS, PIT Program: Pastors in Training Program is a program that teaches and trains young men and women in ministry who are pursuant of the call to pastoral ministry, through hands-on instruction, he prepares them to be successful in building productive lives.
