Resolution authorizing the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, to enter into a Professional Services Agreement or Agreements with Penn State Cooperative Extension for horticultural consulting services in conjunction with the City's Green Up Pittsburgh program. ## Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

**Section 1.** The Mayor, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, is hereby authorized to enter into a Professional Services Agreement or Agreements with Penn State Cooperative Extension for horticultural consulting services in conjunction with the City's Green Up Pittsburgh program at a cost not to exceed Thirty thousand (\$30,000.00) Dollars. Such amounts shall be payable from the following:
