Resolution authorizing the Mayor and the Director of the Department of Public Works to enter into an Agreement, Agreements, and/or Amendments with the United States Army Corps of Engineers (“USACE”) for the purpose of a land survey and stream gauge installation by the USACE at Frick Park, at no cost to the City.

WHEREAS, the land affected by this purpose is within Frick Park, parcel number 127-H-100-0-1; and

WHEREAS, this land access includes the ingress and egress on other lands not described above, provided such ingress and egress as necessary and not otherwise conveniently available to the USACE; and

WHEREAS, the USACE seeks to survey, make test borings, install water gauges, and carry out such other exploratory work as may be necessary to complete an investigation being made of said land(s).

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and the Director of the Department of Public Works are hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement, Agreements, and/or Amendments with United States Army Corps of Engineers (“USACE”) for the purpose of a land survey and stream gauge installation by the USACE at Frick Park, at no cost to the City.

Section 2. The Agreement and Amendments thereto shall be approved by the City Solicitor as to form.
