Resolution authorizing the Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh to submit an Application to the Pennsylvania Office of the Budget for a Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program grant of up to \$500,000 for the Pittsburgh Parks Conservancy project. (Council Districts 3 & 6)

Whereas, the City of Pittsburgh (the “City”) and the Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh (“URA”) wish to obtain from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Office of the Budget (the “Commonwealth”) a grant under the Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program (“RACP”) of up to \$500,000 to be used for the Pittsburgh Parks Conservancy project (the “Project”); and

Whereas, the Commonwealth requires the City to agree to reimburse it for any expenditure of RACP funds determined by the Commonwealth to be ineligible;

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. The Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh is hereby authorized to file an application with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Office of the Budget for a grant under the Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program of up to \$500,000 for the Pittsburgh Parks Conservancy Project.

Section 2. The City agrees to reimburse the Commonwealth for any expenditure of RACP funds in the amount of \$500,000 determined by the Commonwealth to be ineligible.
