<b>Title:</b>	Resolution amending Resolution No. 612, effective October 28, 2009, entitled: "Resolution providing for an Agreement or Agreements with various community organizations for operational/administrative expenses, maintenance, purchase of equipment and/or rehabilitation of neighborhood facilities and the benefit of residents of the City of Pittsburgh; and further, authorizing various City Departments to enter into contract or contracts or use existing contract or contracts for street paving, the purchase of equipment and/or furniture and other related costs at a costs not to exceed \$948,400.00" so as to reprogram funds from City Council from: "Breachmenders Ministries" (-\$2,500); and from the "Center for C.A.R.E.S." (-\$1,000); and from the "Children's Home of Pittsburgh" (-\$1,500); and from the "District 8 Equipment" (-\$1,000); and from the "Family Links" (-\$1,000); and from the "Family Resources" (-\$500); and from the "Floreda Joslyn Taylor" (-\$1,000); and from the "Homewood Meals on Wheels" (-\$1,000); and from the "Kelly Strayhorn Theater" (-\$1,000) (-\$353.00); and from the "Lutheran Services Society" (-\$1,000); and from the "Northside Common Ministries" (-\$1,000); and from the "OPDC-Street Maintenance Graffiti" (-\$1,136.36); and from the "Pittsburgh action Against Rape" (-\$533.33); and from the "Pittsburgh Project" (-\$1,000); and from "District 2 - Equipment" (-1,000); and transfer these funds to the "Center for Victims of Violence & Crime/Pittsburgh" (+\$1,000); and to the Children's Museum of Pittsburgh" (+\$1,000); and to the "Emmaus Community of Pittsburgh" (+\$1,000); and to the "Jewish Association on Aging(Agewell Pgh.
