Ordinance amending the Pittsburgh Code, Title Six Conduct, Article I Regulated Rights and Actions, Chapter 619, Refuse Collection and Recycling, Section 619.01, Definitions, by adding subsection (hh), Residential Structure and by amending Section 619.18; Refuse Collection Times in Residential Zones.

The Council of the City of Pittsburgh hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The Pittsburgh Code, Title Six Conduct, Article I Regulated Rights and Actions, Chapter 619, Refuse Collection and Recycling, Section 619.01, Definitions, by adding subsection (hh), Residential Structure as follows:

§ 619.01 DEFINITIONS

Residential Structure: A structure used or designed to be used primarily for residential occupancy purposes and in which more than half of the floor space is used for residential occupancy purposes. A residential structure may be, but need not be, within an area zoned as a residential district. The term does not include nursing homes, hotels and motels.

Section 2. The Pittsburgh Code, Title Six Conduct, Article I Regulated Rights and Actions, Chapter 619, Refuse Collection and Recycling, by amending Section 619.18, Refuse Collection Times in Residential Zones,

Subsection (a) as follows:

§ 619.18 REFUSE COLLECTION TIMES IN RESIDENTIAL ZONES

(a) No person shall operate any trash, rubbish, garbage, or recycling collection activities within any residentially zoned district, ~~or~~ within 1,000 feet of any residentially zoned district **or within 300 feet of a residential structure** between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.
