*WHEREAS*, First in Math also encourages competition among individual students and teams by awarding virtual "stickers" for every three math problems that are solved correctly; and

**WHEREAS**, studies have shown that students who play the First in Math game on a regular basis experience increased math proficiency, measured by standardized testing; and

**WHEREAS**, now in it's fifth year of implementation, over 12,000 Pittsburgh Public School students, grades 1-8, participate in the First in Math program; and
