Resolution amending Resolution No. 763 approved December 31, 1998, entitled "Amending Resolution No. 221 approved April 15, 1997, entitled amending Resolution No. 578, approved July 31, 1996, entitled amending Resolution No. 206, approved April 11, 1996, entitled providing for implementation of a Residential Parking Permit Program (RPPP) Area "Y" in the Shadyside community (Council District #8) pursuant to Pittsburgh Code Chapter 549", so as to amend streets included in Area "Y".

## Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 1 of Resolution No. 763, approved April 15, 1997, which provides for streets included in Area "Y" and which presently reads as follows:

Within the area bounded by: South Negly Avenue, from Ellsworth Avenue to the Negly Avenue Bridge; College Street, from Ellsworth Avenue to Walnut Street; Holden Street, from Maryland Avenue to College Street; Maryland Avenue, from Ellsworth Street to Elmer Street; Pierce Street, from Summerlea Street to College Street; Summerlea Street, from Pierce Street to Ellsworth Avenue; Alder Street, from Maryland Street to Spahr Street; Elwood Street, from College Street to Lehigh Avenue; Ellsworth Avenue, from Maryland Street to College Street; and Rosary Way, from Elmer Street to Holden Street.

## Is Hereby Amended to Read:

Within the area bounded by: South Negly Avenue, from Ellsworth Avenue to the Negly Avenue Bridge; College Street, from Ellsworth Avenue to Walnut Street; Holden Street, from Maryland Avenue to College Street; Maryland Avenue, from Tay Way to Elmer Street; Pierce Street, from Summerlea Street to College Street; Summerlea Street, from Pierce Street to Ellsworth Avenue; Alder Street, from Maryland Street to Spahr Street; Elwood Street, from College Street to Lehigh Avenue; Ellsworth Avenue, from Summerlea Street to College Street; and Rosary Way, from Elmer Street to Holden Street; and Spahr Street, from College Street to Ellsworth Avenue.
