WHERAS, this year's dinners will be hosted by the Sheraton Station Square, the Omni William Penn, the Westin Convention Center Hotel and the University of Pittsburgh; and

WHEREAS, the hotels and the University of Pittsburgh will serve a full Christmas dinner to ticketed guests from 11AM to 2PM on Saturday, December 25<sup>th</sup>; and

WHEREAS; approximately 2,200 people will receive meals served by more than 400 volunteers from the greater Pittsburgh area; and

WHEREAS, volunteers on that day will include hotel staff who agree to work on their own time on Christmas Day; and

WHEREAS, tickets to the event are distributed through area food banks, social service agencies, and the Salvation Army.
