WHEREAS, Mr. Weinstein is a member of many boards and civic groups, such as The Roberto Clemente Foundation, Animal Friends Inc., Pennsylvania State Tax Collectors Association, Italian Sons and Daughters of America, Variety Club of Western Pennsylvania, and the Vietnam Veterans Leadership Program of Western Pennsylvania ; and

WHEREAS, on February 17, 2011, at the Third Annual Mid-Atlantic Community Fund Dinner, Mr. Weinstein was named *The Samuel Staten Sr. Community Person of the Year*, for his community service;
