**WHEREAS**, First in Math is an online program that helps students develop their math skills, ranging from single-step addition to complex algebra; and

**WHEREAS,** First in Math also encourages competition among individual students and teams by awarding virtual "stickers" for every three math problems that are solved correctly; and

**WHEREAS**, studies have shown that students who play the First in Math game on a regular basis experience increased math proficiency, measured by standardized testing; and

**WHEREAS**, now in it's fifth year of implementation, over 12,000 Pittsburgh Public School students, grades 1-8, participate in the First in Math program; and

**WHEREAS**, Pittsburgh Concord Elementary K-5 placed first in the district-wide First in Math competition; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Cara Christian's second grade classroom at Concord Elementary placed ninth in the United States in the First in Math competition; and

**WHEREAS**, Joseph Johns, a student in Ms. Christian's second grade class is the top First in Math player at Concord Elementary, with 11,150 stickers;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh commends the students and teachers of Concord Elementary School for their outstanding district-wide performance in the First in Math competition; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh congratulates and celebrates the outstanding national performance of Ms. Cara Christian's second grade classroom in the First in Math competition.
