WHEREAS, Program to Aid Citizen Enterprise (PACE), a partner agency of the United Way of Allegheny County, is a non-profit funder and management support organization formed during the Civil Rights Movement of the 1960s; and

WHEREAS, PACE's mission is to strengthen community-based nonprofit organizations that can, potentially or demonstrably, assist African American and economically disadvantaged communities to identify their needs and take effective action; and

WHEREAS, since its inception, **PACE** has provided over \$10 million in grants and technical assistance to over 300 non-profit organizations in isolated and neglected areas of Pittsburgh and Allegheny County; and

WHEREAS, on Friday, March 30, 2012, PACE will host the 4th Annual Inclusive Voices Luncheon, an event like no other in the City, where local community and business professionals, along with emerging and established leaders, will have an opportunity to converse, listen, and learn from one another, connect with one another, and understand one another; and

WHEREAS, this exceptional event has allowed **PACE** to support the communities they serve through a creative and unique opportunity to build connections and uncover new ideas.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh commends **PACE** for their efforts to assist economically disadvantaged communities to take effective action to address their needs.

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh does hereby declare Friday, March 30, 2012 to be **PACE Inclusive Voices Day** in the City of Pittsburgh.
