Resolution amending Resolution No. 579, effective September 13, 2011, entitled: The Mayor and the Director of the Department of City Planning of the City of Pittsburgh are hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement or Agreements, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, with the following various community organizations, for operational/administrative expenses, maintenance, purchase of equipment and/or rehabilitation of neighborhood facilities for the benefit of residents of the City of Pittsburgh and further, authorizing various departments to enter into contract(s) or use existing contract(s) for street paving and other related costs, for the purchase of equipment and/or furniture and installation thereof, at a cost not to exceed \$1,000,000.00, so as to reduce the allocation by \$3,148.25 (Sheptsky Arms-750.00 and Christian Legal Society-WPA Chapter-2,398.25) from \$1,000,000.00 to \$996,851.75.

The Council of the City of Pittsburgh hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Resolution No. 579, effective September 13, 2011, which presently read as follows:
