Resolution providing for the implementation of the Residential Parking Permit Program (RPPP) Area "CC" in the Southside Flats community (Council District #3) pursuant to Pittsburgh Code Chapter 549.

WHEREAS, portions of the Southside Flats community (Council District #3) have petitioned the City in accordance with the established procedures and the City Planning Department has undertaken a parking study which determined that the proposed area is eligible for residential permit parking and a parking management plan has been prepared by the City Planning.

WHEREAS, on September 18, 2012 the City of Pittsburgh Planning Commission voted to negatively recommend this resolution after several public hearings.

**Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:**

**Section 1.** As provided by the Pittsburgh City Code, Chapter 549, entitled "Residential Parking Permit Program," a parking management plan is adopted as follows:

For the Area bounded by: S. 10<sup>th</sup> Street, from Sarah Street to Freyburg Street; S. 11<sup>th</sup> Street, from East Carson Street to Mary Ann Street; S. 12<sup>th</sup> Street, from East Carson Street to Breed Street; S. 13<sup>th</sup> Street, from East Carson Street to Breed Street; S. 14<sup>th</sup> Street, from East Carson Street to Sarah Street; S. 15<sup>th</sup> Street, from East Carson Street and its terminus; S. 16<sup>th</sup> Street, from East Carson Street to Sarah Street; Sarah Street, from S. 10<sup>th</sup> Street to S. 17<sup>th</sup> Street; Roland Way, from S. 12<sup>th</sup> Street to S. 13<sup>th</sup> Street; Roland Street, from S. 15<sup>th</sup> Street to S. 17<sup>th</sup> Street; Freyburg Street, from 10<sup>th</sup> Street to 12<sup>th</sup> Street; Bradish Street, from S. 10<sup>th</sup> Street to S. 12<sup>th</sup> Street; Mary Ann Street, from S. 11<sup>th</sup> Street to S. 12<sup>th</sup> Street; Breed Street, from S. 12<sup>th</sup> Street to S. 15<sup>th</sup> Street; Enon Way, from Sarah Street to Breed Street; and Uxor Way, from Sarah Street to Breed Street.

That motorized vehicle parking shall be restricted to a two (2) hour time limit between the hours of 12:00 p.m. - 12:00 a.m., Monday through Saturday except where existing parking restrictions may exist and vehicles displaying a valid Area "CC" residential permit or visitor's pass; and that residential parking permits be sold only to legal residents or a person who owns or leases commercial property and is actively engaged in a business on property fronting or abutting the above mentioned streets; and that visitor's pass usage shall be limited to no more than three consecutive weekdays on the same vehicle.
