Resolution amending Resolution No. 145, effective March 26, 2012, entitled "Authorizing a Cooperation Agreement with the Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh designating URA as the City's agent for administration of a TIGER IV Grant in an amount up to \$17,000,000 from the U.S. Department of Transportation for the development and construction of the East Liberty Transit Center/Transit Oriented Development project" by reducing the amount of the grant to \$15,000,000, adding an account number and authorizing the Acting Executive Director of URA to sign documents. (Council District 8)

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Resolution No. 145, effective March 26, 2012, which currently reads as follows:

"Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a TIGER IV Grant Cooperation Agreement with Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh ("URA"), in a form approved by the City Solicitor, designating URA as the City's agent for administration of a \$17,000,000 Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery ("TIGER IV) Grant from the U.S. Department of Transportation for the development and construction of the East Liberty Transit Center/Transit Oriented Development project, requiring compliance by URA with federal program requirements, providing for the disbursement of Program funds to URA, and authorizing the Executive Director of URA to sign all invoices, payment applications and requisitions and any other necessary or appropriate documents on behalf of the City as its agent."

is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a TIGER IV Grant Cooperation Agreement with Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh ("URA"), in a form approved by the City Solicitor, designating URA as the City's agent for administration of a \$15,000,000 Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery ("TIGER IV") Grant from the U.S. Department of Transportation for the development and construction of the East Liberty Transit Center/Transit Oriented Development project, requiring compliance by URA with federal program requirements, providing for the disbursement of Program funds to URA, and authorizing the Executive Director or Acting Executive Director of URA to sign the grant application and related documents, all invoices, payment applications and requisitions and any other necessary or appropriate documents on behalf of the City as its agent or designee. Grant funds shall be deposited to the following account: 8229400090.45700."

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Section 2. The following new Section 2 is added:

"Section 2. TIGER IV Grant funds received by the City from the U.S. Department of Transportation shall be paid to URA from the following account: 8229400090.50000."
