**WHEREAS**, Senior Centers throughout the City of Pittsburgh are paying tribute to their local Veterans and thanking them for their devotion to their country.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh does hereby recognize and commend Greenfield's own Veterans for their service; and,
