Resolution vacating an Unnamed Way between Greenfield Avenue and relocated Musgrave Street in the 15<sup>th</sup> Ward, 5<sup>th</sup> Council District of the City of Pittsburgh.

## Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

**Section 1.** WHEREAS, it appears by the petition and affidavit on file in the Office of the City Clerk that the owners of the majority of fronting or abutting on the line of this Unnamed Way in the 15<sup>th</sup> Ward, 5<sup>th</sup> Council District of the City of Pittsburgh, have petitioned the council of the City of Pittsburgh to enact a resolution for the vacation of same, and

WHEREAS, said petition contains inter-alia, an indemnification of the city from any claims and from the payment of any damages whatsoever resulting to any properties owned by the petitioners or by and persons whatsoever, abutting or non-abutting, for or by reason of said vacation; therefore

That vacating an Unnamed Way beginning at a point on Greenfield Avenue, 50 feet wide, at the Northeast corner of Block and Lot 54-N-143 and the Northwest corner of an Unnamed Way; thence Southerly along said Westerly line of said Unnamed Way south 16° 50' 30" East a distance of 336.20 feet to a point at the intersection with relocated Musgrave Street, relocated per Resolution No. 25, 2005.
