WHEREAS, manufacturing is the 3rd largest industry and the 2nd fastest growing industry in Southwestern Pennsylvania; and,

WHEREAS, more than half of high demand manufacturing jobs do not require a 4-year degree but **do** require advance training; and,

WHEREAS, the average salary in manufacturing is \$56,328 for Southwestern Pennsylvania, which is 20% higher than the overall average salary; and,

WHEREAS, New Century Careers, established in 1999 as a nonprofit organization and based in the city's South Side Flats, provides machining classes, National Tooling and Machining Association apprenticeships, incumbent worker training, and the BotsIQ Youth Pipeline program to Southwestern Pennsylvania; and,

WHEREAS, New Century Careers offers continuous workforce education and training that helps preemployment and incumbent manufacturing workers and their current and future employers to advance economically, having, since its inception, trained over 4,000 local workers; and,
