Resolution Amending Resolution 17 of 2015, effective January 27, 2015, to clarify the approved uses of grant funds from Richard King Mellon Foundation.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

Resolution 17 of 2015, effective January 27, 2015, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a Grant Agreement with the Richard King Mellon Foundation for the receipt of grant monies in the amount of four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000). Per the letter attached hereto as Exhibit A, this grant funding may be used to create a Regional Data Resource Center and to improve internal operations and includes support of the Code for America Program. [will be used to create a regional data resource center to serve as a data sharing center.] The Grant Agreement shall be approved as to form and substance by the City Solicitor and monies shall be deposited into the JDE# 0229400142.48311.00 for Budget Year 2015.

Section 2. The Mayor, on behalf of the City of Pittsburgh, is hereby further authorized to enter into agreement or agreements, contract or contracts, and to make all legitimate expenditures required under the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement with the RK Mellon Foundation outlined in Section 1 of this resolution. Said agreement or agreements, contract or contracts, or expenditures shall not exceed four hundred thousand (\$400,000.00) chargeable to and payable from the JDE# 0229400142.50000.00 for Budget Year 2015.
