WHEREAS, the 7th Annual Breakfast also features Women of Achievement, Spirit of 19th Amendment award winners Connie Portis, Publisher and President of Connie Portis Enterprises and Jann Chirdon, Political Strategist; and,

WHEREAS, proceeds from the event will benefit the Pennsylvania Women's Hall of Achievement, which was established to honor women of achievement, educate the public about the accomplishments of women, and to establish educational exhibits that highlight the role women have played in the home, in politics, in the arts, and in our communities; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh does hereby recognize and honor Bonnie DiCarlo and JoAnn Forrester for creating and sustaining Celebrate & Share, and for their long-standing commitment to recognizing the accomplishments of women; and,
