WHEREAS, on Saturday, September 26, 2015, PFWPA will hold its annual fundraiser walk, "Step Forward Pittsburgh", at the Highland Park reservoir; and,

WHEREAS, the day promises to be filled with entertaining games, huge prizes, upbeat music, cooling refreshments and for the entire family; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh does hereby commend the Parkinson Foundation Western PA for its contributions to people with Parkinson disease and congratulates them on their 20th Anniversary; and,
