WHEREAS, a dedicated number of groups in Pittsburgh work year-round to promote understanding, acceptance, and equality for LGBT individuals, including the Gay and Lesbian Community Center, the PERSAD Center, New Voices Pittsburgh, Café Con Leche, Dreams of Hope, and many important others; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Council of the City of Pittsburgh does hereby commend and celebrate the role that our LGBT residents have have played in enriching the culture and history of the City of Pittsburgh, and does hereby declare the month of **October, 2015** to be **LGBT History Month** in the City of Pittsburgh.
