WHEREAS, the pet-therapy program provides therapy to nursing facilities, hospitals, doctors' offices, and schools. The program acts as a fundraiser for numerous causes, including the American Cancer Society, Alzheimer's research, family shelters, and animal shelters; and,

WHEREAS, the pet therapy program continues today through the loss of Athena and Anastasia with Arianna and Sebastian. Arianna and Sebastian "bring smiles to everyone they meet" as pet therapy dogs. Arianna, Sebastian and Friends continue to grow the pet therapy program with help from Laura and support from Three Rivers Hospice and Family Home Health Services. The pet therapy program truly is "The Home That Anastasia Built;" and,
